

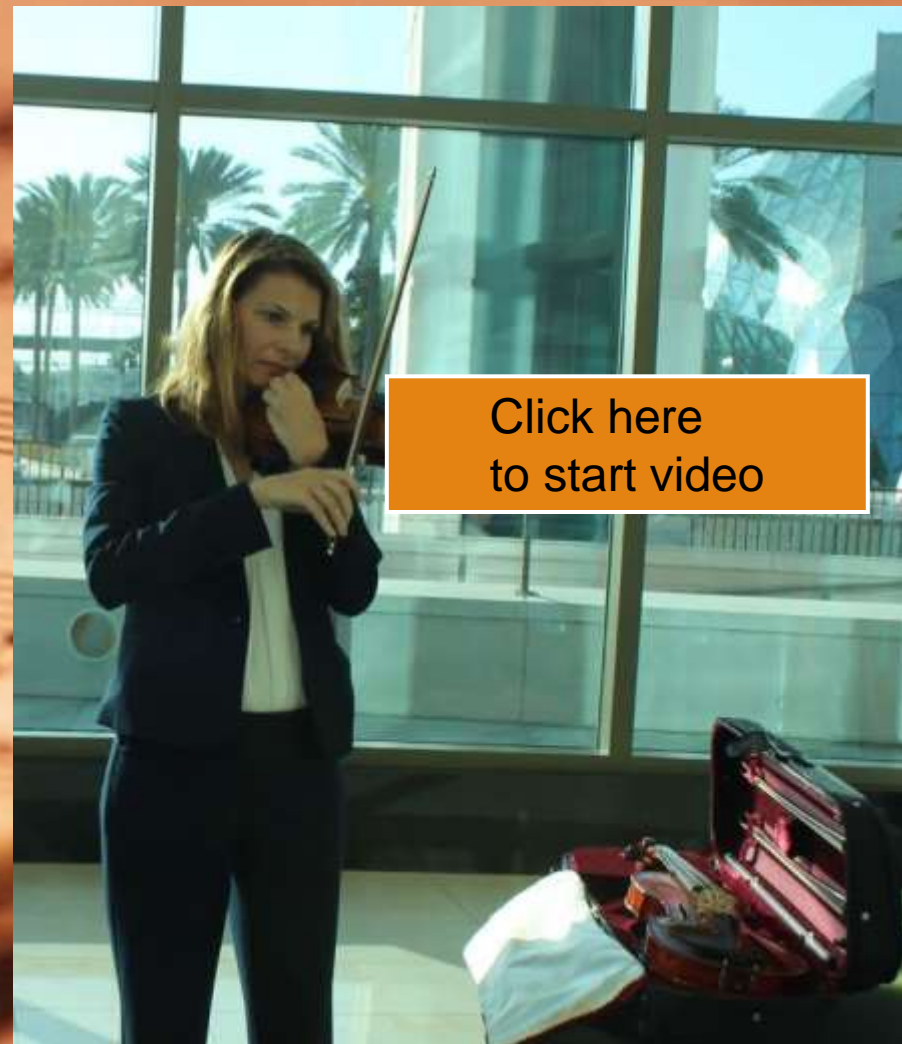

# Parts of the Violin

- Shoulder Rest
- Chin Rest
- Tail Piece
- Neck
- Finger Board
- Tuning Pegs

# Things to Consider

- Temperature – Instrument should be kept only in environments where a person is comfortable – not too hot, not too cold.
- Instrument is mostly comprised of wood, varnish and glue.
- Cleaning kits provide a polish and soft cloth to be used for cleaning the rosin dust and finger prints off the instrument. Do not use water or harsh cleaners on the instrument.
- The bridge is held in place by pressure from the strings.
- The tuning pegs are held in place by pressure. Peg dope can be rubbed on the pegs to increase friction and reduce slippage.
